

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

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Dance / Course Content

The Bachelor of Arts in Dance program trains dancers and offers specializations in Performative Practice and Dance Mediation. The program supports the development of individual artistic profiles and provides a learning environment that values the unique strengths and talents of each student.

The Dance program attempts to be both diverse and comprehensive, and offers a broad range of training formats, methodological insights, and



analytical skills. Physical and practical tools are taught through contemporary dance techniques and ballet for contemporary dancers. Students are able to explore movement beyond mere technical aspects, delving into various disciplines of the dance realm. These include artistic-choreographic methods, diversity-sensitive body discourses, participatory and interdisciplinary approaches, and improvisational-compositional techniques.

The program is designed to prepare students to work and research artistically on a high level, and aims to equip them with the skills needed to excel in their future careers within the professional dance field.

The program is based at the Center for Contemporary Dance (CCD/ZZT), which is well-connected to the dance community in Germany and worldwide. Students benefit from opportunities to participate in projects and collaborate with the vibrant dance scene in North Rhine-Westphalia (NRW), as well as national and international projects. Project work is a key component of the program, offering students the chance to gain practical experience in production-related fields such as dramaturgy, public relations, stage realization, lighting, and sound, alongside their artistic practice.

Career Prospects

The program qualifies graduates for a range of professional roles in the dance field with a focus on either performance or dance facilitation. In addition to a formation as a dancer, the degree – depending on individual focus – also serves as a foundation for entering or further qualifying in areas such as choreography, body and movement therapy, training, production, or dramaturgy. It also provides access to advanced master's programs in Dance Studies or Mediation in Dance, and equips graduates with the ability to transfer knowledge and methods into other fields.
